		<b>Applicant's passport valid for at least 12 months</b> , with a minimum of one blank page.
		<b>2 Application Forms, one in Spanish (for the embassy) and one in English (for the applicant)</b>
		<b>Two good quality recent color passport photographs</b> on white background
		<b>One photocopy of the data page of applicant's passport.</b>
		<b>One copy of the Spanish "Documento Nacional de Identidad" or Identity Card/Passport of the EU-citizen</b> living in Spain, endorsed by a "Notario Público" in Spain.
		<b>Original and a photocopy of the Applicant's Birth Certificate</b> legalized by the Foreign Affairs Ministry of Pakistan and subsequently by the Embassy of Spain to Pakistan. Then an authorized translator must translated it into Spanish.
		<b>Original and a photocopy of the "Acta de Manifestaciones"</b> endorsed by a "Notario Público" in Spain, stating the consent of the EU-citizen for the applicant to travel or be reunited with him/her in Spain.
		Original and a photocopy of the <b>Family Registration Certificate</b> legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Pakistan and subsequently by the Embassy of Spain to Pakistan. <b>ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE FAMILY HAVE TO BE INCLUDED IN THE CERTIFICATE.</b> Then an authorized translator must translate it into Spanish.
		<i>Only if the minor is going to travel to Spain alone while his/her Pakistan father/mother remains in Pakistan:</i> <b>Original and a photocopy of an authorization</b> from the parent residing in Pakistan for the minor <b>to travel out of Pakistan</b> and to reside with the parent permanently in Spain. This document must be legalized by the Foreign Affairs Ministry of Pakistan and subsequently by the Embassy of Spain to Pakistan. Then an authorized translator must translate it into Spanish.
		<i>Only if one of the parents is deceased:</i> <b>Original and photocopy of the official Death Certificate.</b> This document must be legalized by the Foreign Affairs Ministry of Pakistan and subsequently by the Embassy of Spain to Pakistan. Then an authorized translator must translate it into Spanish.
		<b>Old passports</b> of the father/mother living in Spain from the year previous to the birth date of the minor <b>OR</b> a Travel History ( <b>FIA</b> ) of the father/mother living in Spain from the year previous to the birth date of the minor
